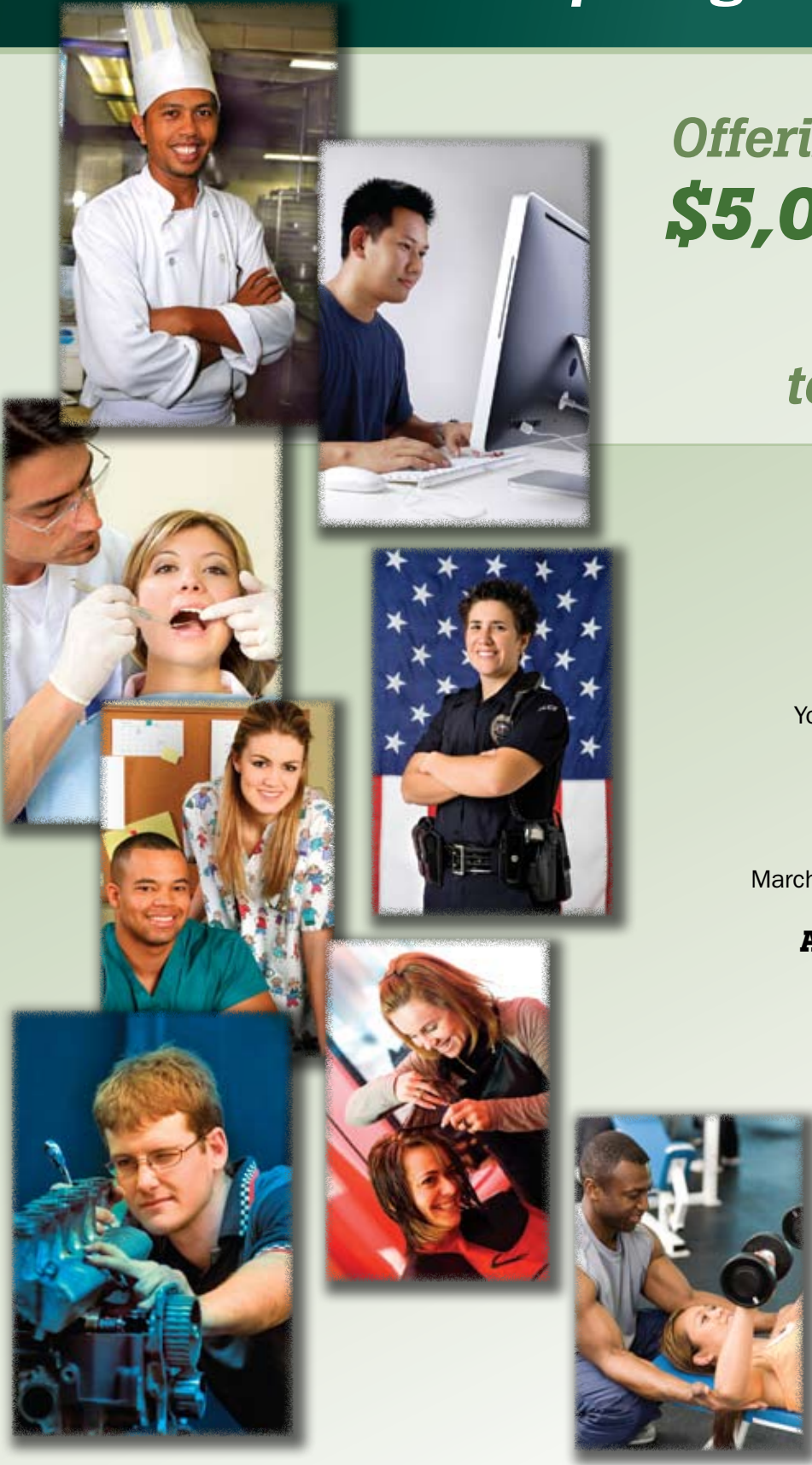

APPLICATION PROCESS

Complete all fields as specified.

School Code: Each career school or college offering a scholarship has a unique alphabetic code in parentheses next to its name. Please indicate the school code associated with the school that you are applying to attend.

Program Code: Each program has a unique 3-digit number located next to the program. Please indicate that number on your application corresponding to the scholarship for which you are applying.

Applicant Data: Complete all personal information including your name, address, date of birth, phone number, graduating high school name, address, and phone number. Please list the month and year you expect to graduate or obtain your GED. Include your parent/guardian's name, address and phone number.

Signature Required: Your signature authenticates your application and certifies that all information provided on the application is correct.

DOCUMENTS

Transcripts: An official transcript, sent by your high school, reflecting seven consecutive semesters of high school and a cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.0 or higher. Photocopies will not be accepted.

Essay: Each applicant is required to submit a 300 word minimum essay. Each of the following three questions must be answered with a minimum of 100 words per question:

Why have you chosen this particular career?

How will this program of study help you obtain that career?

Why do you want to attend this particular institution?

The essay must be typewritten on standard 8 ½ x 11 sized paper and must include your name, address, and high school name in the upper left-hand corner. The essay must be signed by the applicant and include a statement indicating that it was written without assistance from another person. No hand written essays will be accepted. Applicants applying for multiple scholarships must submit a separate essay for each scholarship application.

STATUS OF APPLICATION

If you would like to confirm that your application was received or check the status of your application please contact the FAPSC office via email at scholarship@FAPSC.org.

NOTIFICATIONS

FAPSC nomination committee will be reviewing students' applications between March and early April. Letters of notification will be sent to all applicants notifying them if they were awarded a scholarship. All scholarships are provided by the participating institution and the recipient must meet all admission requirements of the awarding institution.

Unfortunately, the FAPSC staff cannot provide information as to why a student was not selected as a scholarship recipient.

AWARDING

Scholarship award amounts vary depending on the scholarship type. Some scholarships are for full tuition costs and others are partial tuition scholarships in the amount of \$5,000 and \$1,000. Full tuition scholarships cover the cost of tuition whereas partial scholarships are a one-time award in the amount of \$5,000 and \$1,000. Registration, processing fees, books, lab charges, and student activity fees are not covered by the scholarship and are to be paid by the student. The costs vary depending on the institution and course of study. Please contact the individual institution directly about what is included in their scholarship. Awards are disbursed directly by the institution. Scholarships may only be used for the 2009-2010 academic year, and may not be applied toward tuition to a future academic year. Scholarship awards are not transferable.

INSTRUCTIONS

To enter the scholarship competition, applicants must complete the application and mail all supporting documentation to FAPSC. All applications and supporting documentation must be postmarked by **March 6, 2009**.

Applicants may apply for no more than three (3) scholarships from the same institution. Please use a separate application for each scholarship. Scholarship recipients will only be awarded one (1) scholarship. If you are applying for more than one scholarship, please indicate order of preference on the application.

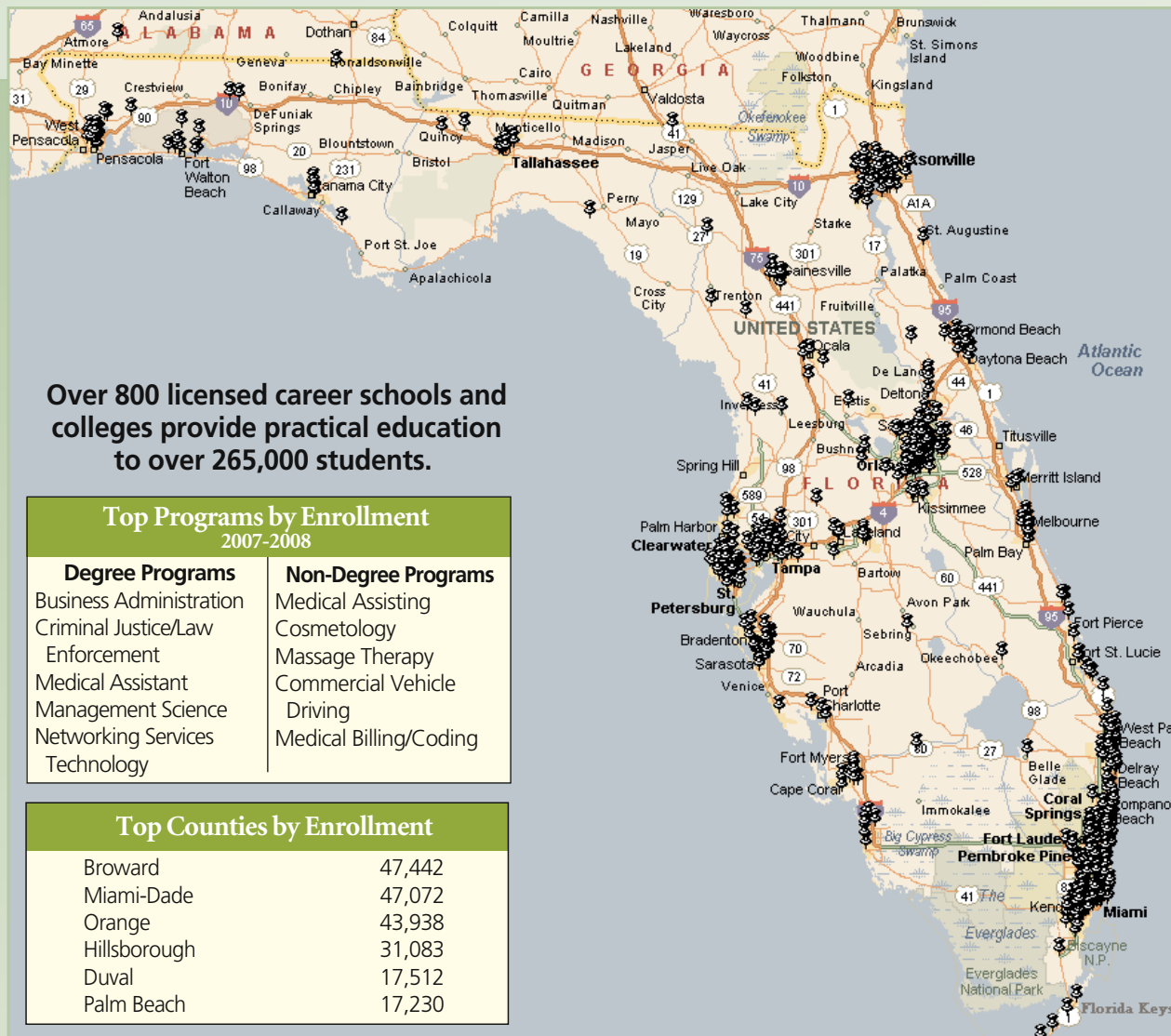
